Interactive survey finds health ranks higher than economy in concerns of Canadians

OTTAWA — Even in the middle of an economic downturn, Canadians are more concerned about health care than about the economy, according to a survey by a Canadian public affairs re-

search company that is being used as the basis of an interactive web-based survey called the Concern Index.

Health ranked 82 on a scale from 1 to 100 in terms of areas of concern, making it No. 1. On the

other hand, swine flu was second only to salmon farming as the least pressing concern, suggesting that Canadians are not buying into the global fears over a possible pandemic.

“Health as the number one

concern among Canadians is consistent with past surveys we have done,” says Dr. Brian Owen, president of NRG Research Group. “But those surveys were conducted before the meltdown of the global econo-

my. So it’s surprising that the economy is of secondary concern after health. And even though Canadians’ health is the highest concern, there’s a low concern over the possibility of a global pandemic.”

The telephone survey to a sample of 1,000 people was completed between May 13 and 17. The margin of error is 3.16 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.
